

APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR CITIZENS' BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

IMPERIAL UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT

NOTICE is hereby given that the Imperial Unitied School District has established a Citizens' Oversight Committee to oversee expenditures of Measure O bond funds, which was the bond measure approved by District voters on November 8, 2016. The District is presently accepting applications from interested citizens to serve on the Committee. The Committee will consist of seven members which meet, review and report on expenditures of bond funds to ensure money is used only for voter-approved purposes. Maintaining a committee to review expenditures is required by law and was promised to District voters as part of the accountability provisions in the bond measure. Interested persons may obtain an application from the Superintendent's Office, located at 219 North E St, Imperial, CA, or download the application from the District's website at https://sites.google.com/imperialusd.org/imperialusd/home. Applications are due by January 31, 2017 at the office of the Superintendent.

Membership. The Committee shall consist of a minimum of 7 members appointed by the District Board based on criteria established by Proposition 39, as follows:

- One (1) member active in a business organization representing the business community located in the District.
- One (1) member active in a senior citizen's organization.
- One (1) member active in a bona-fide taxpayers association.
- One (1) member shall be a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District.
- One (1) member shall be both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the district and active in a parent-teacher organization or school site council.
- Two (2) members of the community at-large appointed by the Board.
